

Terms and Conditions for Teachers of the Edith Parsons School of Physical Culture Incorporated

EP Teacher must be 18 yrs or older as at 31st August this year and

- is not teaching for any other Physical Culture organisation whilst registered as a EP Teacher
- will honour the EP teachers Code of Conduct set out below

Edith Parsons School of Physical Culture CODE OF CONDUCT

- Keep up to date with EP's rules and ensure that you and your members comply with them.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all members regardless of their ability or cultural origin.
- Remember that children participate for pleasure and winning is only part of the fun.
- Be reasonable in your demands on members' time, energy, enthusiasm and attention span.
- Never ridicule or yell at a member for making a mistake or for losing.
- Give all members equal opportunity to participate and ensure that they get equal time and attention from you regardless of their talent.
- Teach your members good sporting behaviour as well as the basics.
- Set an example: your behaviour and comments should be positive and supportive. Your appearance and the language you use should also set a good example.
- Applaud all competitors and teams not just those from your own club.
- Condemn any unsporting behaviour from parents or competitors. Reward good behaviour in individuals and in teams.
- Respect the decisions of the judges and teach your students to do likewise. If you criticise
 the judges to your members, they may lose faith in their sport and not want to compete
 again.
- Keep your knowledge of children's growth and development up-to-date.
- Distribute a code of conduct to your members and parents and encourage them to abide by it. They should be accountable for their behaviour. Display it in your club and promote it at meetings.
- Be open to feedback about your teaching and address conflict openly, honestly and respectfully.
- When running competitions, treat all competitors fairly, treat them with respect and compassion and encourage good sportsmanship from everyone.
